NOMINATIONS FOR ATHLETE

Gymnasts may be nominated as an individual or a team. In order to be considered, the following eligibility criteria are used as a guideline:

- A period of 5yr. post last international competition to which the individual competed as a U.S. National Team Member
- Has been an Olympic, Pan American, World University Games or World Championships team member
- Has been a National Champion recognized by the National Governing Body (AAU, USGF or USAGym)
- Has been a National Collegiate Champion

Please submit with nomination – support documentation that demonstrates the nominee's participation in one or more of the following categories:

1. Gymnastics club(s) or school(s) where athlete trained. Please include the number of years trained and the coach(es) with whom the athlete trained in each program.
2. Athlete's competitive history in chronological order (with dates and titles). Please include the following items:
 - highlight the outstanding competitive accomplishments of individual
 - attach complete competitive records, if possible
 - include information such as national championships won, listing specific events and/or all-around
 - list international competitive records, listing any events or all-around championships won
 - list any honors awarded to the athlete
3. Any additional information about this individual

NOMINATIONS FOR COACH

Coaches may be nominated either as individuals or as members of a coaching partnership. In order to be considered, the following eligibility criteria are used as a guideline:

1. Minimum fifteen (15) years of experience as a coach.
2. Coached athlete(s) who were Olympic, World Championship, Pan American or World Games team members/medalists.
3. Coached National Champion(s) recognized by a National Governing Body (AAU, USGF, USA Gymnastics).
4. Coach of Senior National Team members, recognized international teams, or NCAA championships teams/individuals.

Please submit with nomination – support documentation that demonstrates the nominee's participation in one or more of the following categories:

- Coaching positions held including club/institution and dates.
- Athletes coached and their competitive achievements.
- Domestic and international coaching accomplishments including dates, results, Senior National Team members, etc.
- Any additional information that may support the nomination such as awards received, other contributions to the sport (athlete, judge, volunteer), presentations or publications, etc.

All nominations must be submitted with support documentation that provides proof of the nominee's accomplishments within the sport. Nominations submitted without significant documentation of nominee's accomplishments will be returned to the nominator and will not be considered for the nomination. Nominations for the Class of 2018 Hall of Fame must be completed and copies sent by June 1, 2017 to Erica Koven at USA Gymnastics. Nominations received after that date will not be considered for the 2018 Hall of Fame class.
