NOMINATIONS FOR LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT

In order to be considered, the following eligibility criteria are used as a guideline:

- Has a minimum of twenty years of service
- Has served significantly on national committees
- Holds national and "brevet" credentials as a judge frequently judging at national and international meets
- Invented devices that advance the technical performance of gymnasts elements or promote a safe gymnastics environment
- Has written or contributed to significant gymnastics books, monographs, and articles
- Has produced research advancing the sport
- Author, clinician or educator on a national level

Please submit with nomination – support documentation that demonstrates the nominee's participation in one or more of the following categories:

1. List significant ways in which this nominee has contributed to the gymnastics field:
 - National committees (years and offices held)
 - Regional and state service (years and offices held)
 - Books or articles published
 - Development of significant ideas which have benefited the gymnastics community
 - Judging service and major assignments (Olympic, World Championships, international and/or national competitions)
 - Service to the gymnastics community (volunteer contributions not covered above)
2. Was this nominee a competitor in gymnastics? If so, list background, years and results.
3. Was the nominee a gymnastics coach? If so, list years and achievements.
4. List additional information. (i.e, honors received, gymnastics recognition, etc.)
5. List names, addresses and telephone numbers (with area code) of additional persons who might add to the information listed here on behalf of the nominee.

All nominations must be submitted with support documentation that provides proof of the nominee's accomplishments within the sport. Nominations submitted without significant documentation of nominee's accomplishments will be returned to the nominator and will not be considered for the nomination.
